Since 2005, \$5 million has been brought to Northeast Michigan to leverage \$1.5 million of road commission funding.

Undersized & misaligned culverts cause flooding & road washout during rainfall.

Too-small culverts speed water flow & block wildlife from getting upstream.

Appropriately sized structures let the river flow naturally & let wildlife through.

Improved infrastructure makes community travel & access safer & more enjoyable.

Well-designed road crossings need less maintenance, are safer for people who use them & have positive benefits for wildlife.
